## Investigations under way for Mount Gambier gas incident

Epic Energy personnel from Adelaide are on the ground in Mount Gambier and are onsite at the meter station this morning investigating an issue that occurred last night.

The incident has interrupted gas supply to the Mount Gambier township.

The South East Pipeline System meter station delivers gas into the APA-operated network supplying gas to the township of Mount Gambier.

The Kimberley Clark production facility is not affected.

Mount Gambier-based personnel were immediately dispatched last night to investigate and were unable to restore supply. Epic Energy personnel were then immediately sent from Adelaide last night and arrived on site before 7am today.

They are working as quickly as possible to establish what occurred and determine the repairs required and a timeline for reinstating gas flows. Epic Energy apologises for the inconvenience this causes.
